Important Notice to all Chief Administrative Officers And Elected Officials

Municipal Service Delivery Improvement Program

The Municipal Service Delivery Improvement Program (MSDIP) was announced on March 11 and the application intake is now open until April 30, 2021. The MSDIP is a voluntary program that will allow municipalities and planning districts to conduct value-for-money service delivery reviews. The reviews will result in recommendations that, if adopted by municipalities, will help them find savings. A total of \$5M has been allocated towards this program, to be distributed as outlined in the program guideline.

Under the MSDIP, successful applicants will be paired up with qualified firms who will conduct value-for-money reviews – the cost of which will be covered by the Government of Manitoba.

Any savings identified will stay with municipalities and can be reallocated to municipal priorities. The province has committed to maintaining funding levels to municipalities as promised in Budget 2020 and will not reduce any of that funding based on implemented savings by municipalities from this program.
