## Important Notice to all Elected Officials

## Reminder that Temporary Suspension of Local Government Provisions expire on July 31, 2021

As Manitoba progresses with the '4-3-2-One Great Summer' Reopening Path to allow for fewer restrictions and further rebuild our economy, additional COVID-19 pandemic response measures are concluding. On July 31, 2021, Orders regarding the Temporary Suspension of Local Government Provisions enacted under *The Emergency Measures Act* will end. Effective August 1, 2021, the temporary suspension of provisions relating to byelections to fill a vacancy on council; notices of public hearings and other public notices, and various planning-related approvals and certificates will no longer be in place.

While Manitoba remains in **ORANGE: Restricted** level on the pandemic response system, municipalities are encouraged to continue safe COVID-19 prevention practices in all municipal activities.

Manitoba Municipal Relations continues to monitor the impacts of the pandemic to municipal activities and will reassess future requirements for Temporary Suspension Orders, as needed.
