COVID-19 UPDATE FOR MUNICIPALITIES

Municipal Relations advises that changes to the COVID-19 public health orders took effect at 12:01am on Tuesday October 26, 2021 and will continue to be in effect until 12:01am on Tuesday November 16, 2021. The current public health orders may be viewed by visiting: https://www.gov.mb.ca/covid19/prs/index.html. Manitoba remains at the ORANGE: Restricted level on the pandemic response system.

The new public health orders removed capacity restrictions for retail businesses in select municipalities. All other public health orders issued on October 5, 2021, as outlined in Bulletin #2021-52, remain unchanged.

<u>Capacity Limits for Retail Businesses:</u> Capacity limits for retail businesses are 100 per cent in the Interlake-Eastern, Northern, Prairie Mountain Health and the Winnipeg capital region. Retail capacity limits in the RM of Cartier, RM of Headingley, RM of Macdonald, RM of Ritchot, Town of Niverville, RM of St. Francois Xavier, and RM of Taché have also been raised to 100 per cent. Retail capacity limits in all other municipalities in Southern Health-Santé Sud remain at 50 per cent.
