Municipal Service Delivery Improvement Program

The Manitoba government has launched the second intake of the Municipal Service Delivery Improvement Program. The application for the second intake is now open until Sept. 5, 2022. The MSDIP is a voluntary program that will allow municipalities and planning districts to conduct value-for-money service delivery reviews that will result in recommendations that if adopted by municipalities, will help them find savings. A total of \$1.7M has been allocated towards this program in 2022/23.

Under the MSDIP, successful applicants will be paired up with qualified firms who will conduct value-for-money reviews – the cost of which will be covered by the Government of Manitoba.

These savings found will stay with municipalities and can be reallocated to your members priorities. The province has committed to maintaining funding levels to municipalities as promised in Budget 2022 and will not reduce any of that funding based on implemented savings by municipalities from this program.
