Changes to Speed Limit Authority

As of March 1, 2019, the Minister of Infrastructure is responsible for setting speed limits on roads under provincial authority. These include Provincial Trunk Highways (PTH) and Provincial Roads (PR), as well as provincial highways or roads that pass through a village, town or city within a municipality.

Municipalities are responsible for making bylaws that set speed limits on roads under their authority, such as municipal and community roads. Resources to assist municipalities with setting speed limits and developing bylaws are available at: www.gov.mb.ca/mit/traffic/speed
