

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
BY THE MUNICIPAL BOARD OF MANITOBA**

**RE: RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF STANLEY – ZONING BY-LAW NO. 2-26
OBJECTION TO ZONING BY-LAW FROM PUBLIC AUTHORITY
FILE NO. 26B3B-0001**

IN THE MATTER OF: The Rural Municipality of Stanley (the “Municipality”) By-law No. 2-26 (the “Proposed By-law”) amending Zoning By-law 8-18. The Proposed By-law seeks to amend the Municipality’s Zoning By-law No. 8-18 (the “Zoning By-law”) by adding the use of “Heavy Equipment Sales, Service, and Rental” in the Use Table as “C” in the AL Zone.

AND IN THE MATTER OF: Objection from Public Authority to the Proposed By-law received by the Municipality and referral of the Objection to The Municipal Board (the “Board”) under Section 78(1) of *The Planning Act*.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that, under the provisions of *The Planning Act*, C.C.S.M. c. P80, and *The Municipal Board Act*, C.C.S.M. c. M240, the Board will hold a public hearing to receive representations from any person on the objections regarding the Proposed By-law.

The public hearing will take place on **Monday, October 5, 2026**, and, if needed, on **Tuesday, October 6, 2026, and Wednesday, October 7, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.** at the **Rural Municipality of Stanley Council Chambers, 1-23111 PTH 14, Stanley, Manitoba.**

Any interested person may make a representation on the Proposed By-law. A person who wishes to make a written and/or oral presentation to the Board must register by filing a completed Public Presenter Form with the Board at least ten (10) working days prior to the hearing.

The Board requires that an interested person who intends on filing a written submission must file four (4) copies of that material with the Board and one (1) copy with the Rural Municipality of Stanley for public viewing at least ten (10) working days prior to the hearing, failing which copies of the written submission must be provided to the Board and the parties at the hearing.
