Boundary Review Process

Step 1:

Community passes a resolution containing a proposal based on internal community process, meetings, etc.

Step 2:

Community submits resolution/proposal to the regional office.

Step 3:

Regional office refers the resolution/proposal to the Northern Manitoba Community Consultation Board.

Step 4:

The Northern Manitoba Consultation Board reviews the proposal.

Step 5:

The minister receives recommendation(s) from the Northern Manitoba Consultation Board.

If approved:

Step 6:

Boundary drawing is prepared.

Step 7:

Regulation is amended (Status and Boundaries - Unincorporated Communities and Settlements regulation 67/2009).

Step 8:

Regulation is enacted by the minister.

Step 9:

Regulation is published in the Manitoba Gazette.
