**9.4.2M Location and Spacing of Intersections**

**9.4.2.6M Service Roads**

At intersections where service roads parallel a highway, the closest edge of the service road should be at least 50 m from the edge of the nearest travel lane of the highway. This will allow a WB-20 turning off the service road the opportunity to align themselves perpendicular to the highway. A 'bulb out' treatment, like Figure 9.4.5M below, may be required to achieve the 50 m spacing.
