The point(s) at which fish and fish products may enter a chain of custody:

The scope of this certification ends at the point of change in ownership, i.e. purchase by one of the two licensed fish dealers that buy from the fishery. This will be at the Easterville packing shed or when loaded to a reefer truck.

Downstream certification of the product will require appropriate certification of transport, storage and handling facilities.

In order for subsequent links in the distribution chain to be able to use the MSC logo, walleye and northern pike products must enter into a separate chain of custody certification from the Easterville packing shed or when loaded to a reefer truck.

The parties, or categories of parties, that are entitled to use this certificate to enter fish from the certified fishery into certified chains of custody:

The eligible fishers are those who are members of the Cedar Lake Fisheries Inc (limited to 40 licences).
