

Manitoba Launches New Chronic Wasting Disease Dashboard!

Manitoba has been monitoring wild cervids for disease since 1997 and announced its first confirmed case of Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) in November 2021. Since 2021, over 14,000 samples have been tested and 30 positive cases of CWD have been identified in Manitoba.

Hunters, wildlife enthusiasts, stakeholders, and wildlife health officials will now have the most up-to-date CWD data at their fingertips through the new online CWD dashboard! This platform provides a means of viewing information in real time to make informed decisions. Explore data layers, filter map contents by hunting season or species of concern, find directions to your nearest biological sample depot location, and more!

Hunter participation is paramount for CWD surveillance and disease monitoring. Thank you to all hunters for submitting your samples for CWD testing!
