

DRONES AND WILDFIRES

The airspace near wildfire is closed to all aircraft, except those involved in fighting fires.
If you fly a drone over or near a wildfire:

Emergency response teams are forced to ground their operations.

This endangers lives.

You are breaking the law. You could face serious penalties, including fines and jail time.

Before flying a drone, make sure there are no smoke plumes or active wildfires nearby. **Use drones responsibly.**
