OVERVIEW:

A proposal has been filed by Mr. Randell Reimer on behalf of Reimer Welding and Manufacturing for the relocation and operation of a manufacturing development located at Lot 1 Plan 26999 MLTO in SE ¹/₄ 6-2-14 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Roblin. The development involves the manufacture of steel feed hoppers and other custom welding including repairs to farm machinery. Production processes involve plasma cutting, sawing, welding, grinding, sanding and painting. There is a potential for emissions of particulate matter, noise and odour. Normal operation is from 8:00 AM to 5:30 PM Monday through Friday.

The Department provided the Technical Advisory Committee with information on the Proposal and made public notification in the Cartwright Southern Manitoba Review. The following summarizes the responses:

- Item d) There may be some particulate emitted. The need for particulate control devices at this time is not indicated. The standard clauses for particulate emission and monitoring are licenced. The mechanism for further action if needed is provided in the licence.

10. <u>Manitoba Agriculture – Soils and Crops - Soil Resource Section</u> – did not respond.

12. Manitoba Health - Public Health - Environmental Unit - has the following comments:

- b) Monitor and control if applicable odour and sound.

- d) Prevent solvents or other products used or contaminated wastewaters from entering sewage disposal and municipal ditch systems through diking or other appropriate containment measures.
- e) Septic field regulations.
- f) Maintain current inventory lists in designated area.

Disposition:

- Item a) There may be some particulate emitted. The need for particulate control devices at this time is not indicated. The standard clauses for particulate emission and monitoring are licenced.
- Item b) Odour and noise concerns are addressed in the licence.
- Item c) There is not a demonstrated need for this condition at this time.
- Item d) The relevant points in this comment are addressed in the licence.
- Item e) The proponent is bound by all applicable regulations.
- Item f) There is not a demonstrated need for this condition at this time.

13. Manitoba Labour - Workplace Safety and Health Division - did not respond.
