DEFINITIONS

In this Licence.

"as constructed to wags" means engineering drawings complete with all dimensions which indicate all features to be lopmed as it has actually been built.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This Social of the Licence contains requirements intended to provide guidance to the Licencee in implementing practices to ensure that the environment is maintained in such a manner as to sustain a high quality of life, including social and economic development, recreation and leisure for present and future Manitobans.

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- 1. The Licencee shall, in addition to any of the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions specified in this Licence, upon the request of the Director:
 - a) sample, monitor, analyse or investigate specific areas of concern regarding any segment, component or aspect of pollutant storage, containment, treatment, handling, disposal or emission systems, for such duration and at such frequencies as may be specified;
 - b) determine the environmental impact associated with the release of any pollutants from the Development;
 - c) conduct specific investigations in response to the data gathered during environmental monitoring programs; or
 - d) provide the Director, within such time as may be specified, with such sports, d wings, specifications, analytical data, flow rate measurements and such other into pation as may from time to time be requested.
- 2. The Licencee shall operate the water supply system in accordance with Manito a Regulations under the Public Health Act, the Drinking Water Safety Ma, and a opening requirements as recommended by Manitoba Conservation and Manitola Water Stew Idship.
- 3. The Licencee shall collect and dispose of all used il projects of dother regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the operation of the evelopment in accordance with applicable Manitoba Conservation and legislation wire, buts.
- 4. The Licencee shall maintain the water supply were associated with the Development to prevent the contamination of groundwater in a reface rater:
 - a) entering the well casings the high the top of a casings; and
 - b) entering the well casings though the sit is of the casings.
- 5. The Licencee shall:
 - a) prepare as cons ucted drawings for the Development and shall label the drawings "As Constructed"; an
 - b) provide to be Director, within three months of the completion of construction of the Development, two sets of constructed drawings.

S. YCIF CATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Respecting Continues:

- 6. The icencee shall notify the office of Manitoba Conservation Environmental Operations Branch in Dauphin not less than two weeks prior to commencing construction of the Development. The notification shall include the intended starting date of construction and the name of the contractor responsible for the construction.
- 7. The Licencee shall, during construction and operation of the Development:
 - a) immediately report any reportable spills to Manitoba Conservation's Accident Reporting Line at (204) 944-4888; and
 - b) provide a follow-up report to the Director on a reportable environmental accident outlining the cause(s) and proposing corrective action to prevent reoccurrence.

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- 8. The Licencee shall, at all times during the construction of the Development, maintain materials to contain and recover spills of fuel and other fluids associated with construction machinery at construction sites.
- 9. The Licencee shall establish fuel storage and equipment servicing areas for the construction and operation of the Development:
 - a) a minimum distance of 100 metres from any waterbody; and
 - b) in compliance with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 188/2001 espects. Storage and Handling of Petroleum Products and Allied Products, or a future am adment thereof.
- 10. The Licencee shall, during construction of the Development, discusse of con-reusable construction debris at a waste disposal ground operating under the authority of a permit issued under *Manitoba Regulation 150/91* respecting *Waste Disposal Ground*, or any future amendment thereof, or a Licence issued pursuant to The Extrement A

Respecting Operation:

- 11. The Licencee shall obtain and maintain classification with a compent pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 77/2003 respecting Water at the way. Facility Operators, or any future amendment thereof, and maintain compliance with all requirements of the regulation including, but not limited to, the preparation and maintain acceptance of a Table of Organization, Emergency Response Plan and Standard Operation Procedures.
- 12. The Licencee shall carry out the operation of the Development with individuals properly certified to do so pursuant to Anitoba Regulation 77/2003 respecting Water and Wastewater Facility Operators, or Anture mendment thereof.
- 13. The Licencee shall of resulting interconnection of a private water supply system with the Development.
- 14. The Licensee shall operate the Development with respect to the volume and rate of water diverted in a valance with a Water Rights License issued pursuant to the Water Rights Act.
- 15. The Lice cee share ctively participate in any watershed and/or aquifer based management study eing to then, by Manitoba Water Stewardship or any watershed planning authority.

REVIEW AND REVOCATION

- A. If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding or has or is failing to meet the specifications, limits, terms, or conditions set out in this Licence, the Director may, temporarily or permanently, revoke this Licence.
- B. If the Licencee has not commenced construction of the Development within three years of the date of this Licence, the Licence is revoked.

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C. If, in the opinion of the Director, new evidence warrants a change in the specifications, limits, terms or conditions of this Licence, the Director may require the filing of a new proposal pursuant to Section 11 of The Environment Act.
