DEFIN FIONS

In this Licence,

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall, in addition to any of the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions specified in this Licence, upon the request of the Director:
 - sample, monitor, analyse or investigate specific areas of concern regarding any segment, component or aspect of pollutant storage, containment, treatment, handling, disposal or emission systems, for such duration and at such frequencies as may be specified;

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- b) determine the environmental impact associated with the release of any pollutants from the Development;
- c) conduct specific investigations in response to the data gathered during environmental monitoring programs; or
- d) provide the Director, within such time as may be specified, with such reports drawings, specifications, analytical data, flow rate measurements and such other informations may from time to time be requested.
- 2. The Licencee shall design, construct and operate the water treatment and apply system in accordance with Manitoba Regulations under the Public Health Act are the Drinking attractions. Act and all operating requirements as recommended by Manitoba West Stevendship, Obace of Drinking Water.
- 3. The Licencee shall collect and dispose of all used oil product and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction and peration of the Development in accordance with applicable Manitoba Conservation and legislation applicables.

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMP 3, TERMS AND ONDITIONS

Construction - General

- 4. The Licencee shall notify the Northeast Region of the of Manitoba Conservation Environmental Operations Branch not less that two weeks prior to beginning construction of the Development. The notification shall include the intended starting date of construction and the name of the contractor responsible for the contractor.
- The Licencee shall suring the tion of the Development, dispose of non-reusable construction debris at a waste disputal ground operating under the authority of a permit issued under *Manitoba Regulation* 150/91 respecting *Waste Disposal Grounds* or any future amendment thereof, or a Licence issued purpose to the Environment Act.

 - b) pro de a follow-up report to the Director on a reportable environmental accident outlining the ause(s) and proposing corrective action to prevent reoccurrence.

Respecting Operation

7. The Licencee shall obtain and maintain classification of the Development pursuant to *Manitoba Regulation 77/2003* respecting *Water and Wastewater Facility Operators* or any future amendment thereof and maintain compliance with all requirements of the regulation including, but

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not limited to, the preparation and maintenance of a Table of Organization, Emergency Response Plan and Standard Operating Procedures.

8. The Licencee shall carry out the operation of the Development with individuals properly certified to do so pursuant to *Manitoba Regulation 77/2003* respecting *Water and Waster Facility Operators* or any future amendment thereof.

REVIEW AND REVOCATION

- A. If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding a has or is failing to meet the specifications, limits, terms, or conditions set out in this is race, the frector may, temporarily or permanently, revoke this Licence.
- B. If construction of the development has not commenced while three years of the date of this Licence, the Licence is revoked.
- C. If, in the opinion of the Director, new evidence was ants a change in the specifications, limits, terms or conditions of this Licence, the Director may receive the aling of a new proposal pursuant to Section 10 of The Environment Act.
