

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and IKO INDUSTRIES LTD., Applicant

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, IKO Industries Ltd. filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of an asphalt shingle and building paper plant located on Block M, Plan 433 in the Parish of St. Boniface, at or near 421 Archibald Street, in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to the Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS

after advertising the proposal, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person likely to be affected by a Commission order prescribing limits, terms and conditions concerning the proposal;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission considered the proposal on the 17th day of October, 1983;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The Applicant shall not cause or permit the emission of particulate matter from any process of the said operation in excess of 0.57 grams per standard cubic metre calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury at the point of emission.
- 2. The Applicant shall not cause or permit visible emissions from any point of emission of the said operation that exhibit an opacity in excess of:
 - (a) 40 percent for a period of more than 4 minutes in the aggregate in any one hour at the point of emission;
 - (b) 60 percent at any time at the point of emission.

- 3. The Applicant shall limit the emission of odours to such an extent that odours emanating from the said operation are not detectable at any point of impingement past the property line of the said operation when one volume of odorous air is diluted with six equal volumes of odour-free air.
- 4. The Applicant shall maintain a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices at all times consistent with meeting the limits, terms and conditions prescribed in this order.
- 5. This order replaces Order No. 267 which is hereby rescinded.
