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AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
 UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

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RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and NOTRE DAME CREMERIE LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Notre Dame Cremerie Ltd. filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of a creamery located on Lot 1, Block 3, in Section 1, Township 7, Range 9 WPM in the Village of Notre Dame de Lourdes, Manitoba, with discharge of wastewater, in winter, to agricultural land in the SW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 6, Range 8 WPM, and, in Summer, to a slough located in the NW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 6, Range 8 WPM, in the Rural Municipality of Lorne;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits, terms and conditions specifically prescribed for the said operation by a regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS after giving notice of the proposal, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected by the issuance of a Commission order concerning the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the proposal on the 18th day of June, 1985, and the 17th day of July, 1985;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall dispose of wastewater from the said operation, other than sanitary sewage and cooling water discharges, only by one or more of the following acceptable methods:
  - (a) by processing in a dairy manufacturing plant or a buttermilk drying plant for the dehydration of buttermilk and other wastewater components;
  - (b) by utilization as feed for livestock or poultry;
  - (c) by application to soil, except road allowances and/or roadside ditches, such that the maximum rate of application to a land area does not exceed 112,000 litres on any hectare per year, applied in a fashion that ensures uniform spreading and does not result in any ponding on the land surface;

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1. (d) through a waste handling or treatment facility designed and operated to meet discharge limits as established under the said Act or regulations thereunder;

(e) during ice-free periods, by disposal to the said slough.
