UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

- RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE CARMAN-DUFFERIN RECREATION COMMISSION, Applicant,
- WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Carman-Dufferin Recreation Commission filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of a swimming pool located in SE 1/4 of the W 1/2 of Section 25, Township 6, Range 5 WPM in the Town of Carman with discharge of filter backwash water to the Boyne River;
- AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a regulation, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;
- AND WHEREAS after giving notice of its intention to set limits, terms and conditions, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected;
- AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the operation on the 30th day of March, 1988;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The Applicant shall not discharge effluent from the said swimming pool where
  - (a) the fecal coliform content, as indicated by the MPN index, is in excess of 200 per 100 millilitres of sample;
  - (b) the total coliform content, as indicated by the MPN index, is in excess of 1500 per 100 millilitres of sample.
