

## AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE TOWN OF MORDEN, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Town of Morden filed a registration with the department in connection with the operation of lime and soda ash settling ponds located in the SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 3, Range 5 WPM in the said Town with discharge of supernatant effluent to Dead Horse Creek;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a regulation, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS

after giving notice of its intention to set limits, terms and conditions, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the operation on the 30th day of March, 1988;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The Applicant shall not discharge effluent from the said ponds where the suspended material content of the effluent, as indicated by the non-filterable residue, is in excess of 25 milligrams per litre unless the release is authorized by the Environmental Management Division.
- The Applicant shall dispose of waste sludge from the said ponds in a manner satisfactory to the Environmental Management Division.
- 3. The Applicant shall have constructed the said ponds with clay or other material in such a manner that all interior surfaces are underlain with clay or other material having a hydraulic conductivity of  $1 \times 10^{-7}$  centimetres per second or less.
