## NATIONAL CONTAINERS AND RECYCLING LTD.; APPLICANT

The following limits, terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the operation of a recycling transfer station at 606 Provencher Boulevard in the City of Winnipeg:

- 1. The Applicant shall ensure that only materials suitable for recycling, such as glass, metal, paper, corrugated cardboard and wood are brought onto the site.
- 2. The Applicant shall remove material previously deposited on the site, and any materials brought to the site in the future, shall be sorted inside the building which is to be constructed for this purpose.
- 3. The Applicant shall ensure that material being stockpiled on site prior to removal for recycling is stored inside the proposed building or, if stored outside, is placed in bins approved by an Environment Officer.
- 4. The Applicant shall dispose of any residues remaining from the sorting and stockpiling of recyclable materials at a municipal waste disposal site.
- 5. The Applicant shall ensure that all materials entering, leaving, or temporarily held in storage on site shall be handled and stored such that odours are minimized and no litter is created on site or blows off site.
- 6. The Applicant shall maintain and keep available for inspection by an Environment Officer a log of all materials entering the site, quantities leaving the site for recycling and quantities leaving the site for disposal at municipal waste disposal facilities.

7. The provisions of this licence and the operation of National Containers and Recycling Ltd. shall be subject to review on or about the 1st day of May 1992.
