The applicant shall comply with the following limits, terms and conditions for placement of a fish screen near the outlet region of Mary Jane Reservoir, 40. 17' Latitude, 98. 36' Longitude, as shown on Plan #663 Morden Land Titles Office, in accordance with the information filed within the Environment Act Proposal Form dated November 8, 1988:

- A representative sample of the salt intended for mixture with the gravel shall be submitted for chemical analyses to the W.M. Ward Technical Services Lab, 745 Logan Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba. This sample shall be analyzed for arsenic, boron, cadmium, lead, nickel, zinc, calcium, magnesium, manganese, iron, potassium, sodium and chloride.
- 2. The results of the analyses shall be submitted to the Director, prior to placement of the gravel and salt mixture onto the ice surface of Mary Jane Reservoir.
- 3. The placement of the gravel and salt mixture onto the ice surface of Mary Jane Reservoir shall not proceed until written approval of the Director is obtained.
