The applicant shall comply with the following limits, terms and conditions for the modification and management of a small intermittent creek, tributary to the Assiniboine River, in order to create a permanent 6.70 hectare marsh suitable for waterfowl production, located in the Rural Municipality of Arthur on the east half of Section 2, Township 15, Range 29 W1, in accordance with the information filed within the Environment Act Proposal Form dated March 17, 1989:

- (1). Construction shall not proceed until the proponent has provided written evidence to the Director that:
 - (a). A Licence has been obtained pursuant to the Water Rights Act from the Water Resources Branch, Manitoba Department of Natural Resources or the requirements of the Water Rights Act have been satisfactorily met should such a licence not be required.
 - (b). The requirements of the Historical Resources Branch, Manitoba Department of Culture, Heritage and Recreation regarding the protection of significant archeaological resources within the project area have been satisfactorily met.
- (2). All earthworks shall be stabilized in order to prevent soil erosion, with the use of rock or concrete armor, planting of artificial mixtures of plants, natural re-vegetation, and other appropriate measures as indicated in the letter dated May 23, 1989 and detailed on drawing number 535-0520, sheets 1 and 2, dated February 14, 1989.
