The following limits, terms, and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the construction of a temporary sewage sludge dewatering cell and the removal of sewage sludge from a wastewater treatment lagoon located on the SW 1/4 of Section 23-3-4 WPM with final disposal of the sewage sludge at a registered waste disposal ground:

- 1. The Applicant shall construct and operate the temporal sludge dewatering cell in such a manner as to prevent see any from affecting adjacent property.
- 2. The Applicant shall construct a tempority where prevent the wastewater and sludge from the dewatering area entering the active area of the waste disposal ground.
- 3. The Applicant shall remove all carage udge and other solids from the temporary sludge dewatering call within 30 days and shall place the dewatered sludge in a disposal real within the registered waste disposal ground.
- 4. The Applicant shall, ther epositing the dewatered sewage sludge and other solids in the registered waste disposal ground, place an earthen cover with a frimum thickness of 15 centimeters on top of the sewage sludge and other solids.
- 5. The Applicant ball after the sewage sludge and other solids have been removed from the temporary dewatering cell, remove the temporary dikes and restore the dewatering area to its original state.

6. The Applicant shall advise the Director when the project has been completed.
