THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

IMPERIAL OIL LIMITED, BRANDON: "the Licencee"

The following limits, terms, and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the upgrade of the existing bulk petroleum and bulk fertilizer facility located at E 1/2 Section 13, Township 10, Range 19, WPM, (926 Douglas Street and 930 Douglas Street), in the City of Brandon, Manitoba:

LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall limit the emission of particulate matter from the operation to such an extent that airborne particulate matter from any part or process of the operation does not exhibit an opacity greater than 5 percent at any point beyond the property line of the operation.
2. The Licencee shall ensure that any fertilizer spills are contained and cleaned up immediately to prevent soil contamination and the possibility of surface runoff into groundwater.
3. The Licencee shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times consistent with meeting the requirements of this Licence.

REVOICATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
