Plan No. 2347 M.L.T.O., in the N.E. 1/4 of Section 9-2-1-WPM with final disposal of the sewage sludge at a registered waste disposal ground:

- 1. The Applicant shall construct and operate the temporary sudge dewatering cell in such a manner as to prevent seepage from affecting djace t property.
- 2. The Applicant shall remove all sewage sludge and other solids from the temporary sludge dewatering cell within 30 days and shall place the dewatered sludge in a disposal area within the regist red has disposal ground.
- 3. The Applicant shall, after depositing the decatered sewage sludge and other solids in the registered waste disposal graund, place an earthen cover with a minimum thickness of 15 centimetre. In the possible sewage sludge and other solids.
- 4. The Applicant shall, after the sew re slidge and other solids have been removed from the temporary dewatering sell, remove the temporary dikes and restore the dewatering area to its original state.
