THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

NEEPAWA PET FOODS; APPLICANT

The following limits, terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the operation of the Neepawa Pet Foods on Part of the SE \ 31-14-15 in the Town of Neepawa:

- The Applicant shall limit odour emissions to such an extent that, at any point of impingement off the site of the said operation odours emanating from the said operation are not detectable in a residential area or commercial area when one volume of odorous air is diluted with one equal volume of odour-free air.
- 2. The Applicant shall dispose of all solid and liquid wastes from the operation, including renderable wastes, paunch manure and manure within 24 hours of its production or retain such materials in enclosed storage tanks in such a manner that odours are not generated in excess of the limit specified in Clause 1 of this Licence.
- 3. The Applicant shall at all times direct all process waste water, including sanitary sewage to a holding tank. The contents of the holding tank shall be disposed of a licenced wastewater disposal facility.
- 4. The Applicant shall at all times maintain a high standard of equipment, maintenance and good housekeeping practices consistent with meeting the limits, terms and conditions prescribed by this Licence.
- 5. The Applicant shall ensure that all equipment including barrels are stored inside the premises.
- 6. The Applicant shall provide a complete set of plans for the complex prior to construction to the designated Environment Officer.

- 7. The Applicant shall ensure that all renderable waste is forwarded to a licenced rendering plant for disposal.
- 8. The Applicant shall provide water under pressure for washing purposes.
- 9. The Applicant shall provide a refrigerated area for storage prior to transporting product.
