In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125) THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

COSGROVE AUTO BODY: APPLICANT STAGE 2 LICENCE

The following limits, terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the operation of an autobody shop on the SW 1/4, Section 27-10-26 WPM in the Town of Virden:

- 1. The applicant shall collect all drained fluids (gasoline, anti-freeze, crank case and differential fluids) and safely store the fluids in water tight and covered drums prior to reuse or disposal.
- 2. The applicant shall ensure that each drum in which fluids are stored is clearly marked on the side and the top surface identifying the type of fluid.
- 3. The applicant shall ensure that periodic disposal of fluids collected is made by delivery to a facility that is approved to recycle or destroy such fluids.
- 4. The applicant shall ensure that batteries removed from vehicles are stored in a proper and safe manner.
- 5. The applicant shall ensure that no open burning of any material related to the operation takes place.
- 6. The applicant shall ensure that vehicles and miscellaneous waste materials are stored in orderly manner.
- 7. The applicant shall provide the Director a copy of the development agreement to be entered into between himself and the Rural Municipality of Wallace in its entirety.
- 8. The applicant shall ensure that there is no paint overspray beyond the facility property line.
- 9. The applicant shall ensure that the filters used in conjunction with the spray booth are cleaned on a regular basis and kept in good working condition.
- 10. The applicant shall store all paints, thinners and solvents in a safe and satisfactory manner.
- 11. Stage 1 Licence No. 1417 is hereby rescinded.
