THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

INTERLAKE SALVAGE & RECYCLING; APPLICANT STAGE 1 LICENCE

The following limits, terms, and conditions shall be complied with in connection with a scrap processing and auto recycling operation on Lot 2 Block 1 of Plan 23476 in the Town of Stonewall:

- 1. The Applicant shall collect all drained fluids (gasoline, antifreeze, crankcase and differential fluids) and safely store the fluids in water-tight and covered drums prior to re-use or disposal.
- 2. The Applicant shall ensure that each drum in which fluids are stored is clearly marked on the side and on the top surface identifying the type of fluid therein.
- 3. The Applicant shall ensure that periodic disposal of fluids collected will be made by delivery to a facility that is approved to safely reclaim or destroy such fluids.
- 4. The Applicant shall maintain a written record of all disposal of fluids as referenced in Clause 3. The record shall contain the date of disposal, the quantity and type of fluid disposed of and the location of disposal.
- 5. The Applicant shall ensure that no chemicals are handled by the operation.
- 6. The Applicant shall ensure that no battery breaking takes place at the operation. All batteries are to be stored upright in leak free containers prior to recycling.

- 7. The Applicant shall ensure that no open burning of any kind takes place at the operation.
- 8. The Applicant shall ensure that the site is contained by a perimeter chain link fence a minimum of 6 feet in height. In addition the front portion of the fence is to be solid.
- 9. The applicant shall ensure that all scrap materials are stored within the fenced area.
- 10. The Applicant shall ensure that there is no permanent storage of vehicles at the operation.
- 11. The Applicant shall ensure that the operation is conducted in such a manner as to prevent the contamination of groundwater.
- 12. The Applicant shall ensure that no smelting or refining takes place at the operation until a Stage 2 Licence under The Environment Act is issued.
