The applicant shall comply with the following limits, terms and conditions for the construction and management of a single-celled marsh suitable for waterfowl production located in the Rural Municipality of Wallace on the southwest quarter of Section 31, Township 12, Range 27 WPM, and the southeast quarter of Section 36, Township 12, Range 28 WPM, in accordance with the information filed within the Environment Act Proposal Form dated October 28, 1990:

- (1) Construction shall not proceed until the proponent has provided written evidence to the Director that a Licence has been obtained pursuant to the Water Rights Act from the Water Resources Branch, Manitoba Department of Natural Resources or the requirements of the Water Rights Act have been satisfactorily met should such a licence not be required; and
- (2) All earthworks shall be stabilized in order to prevent soil erosion, with the use of rock or concrete armour, planting of artificial mixtures of plants, natural re-vegetation, and other appropriate measures that may be specified by the Director; and
- (3) The applicant shall meet the requirements of the Historic Resources Branch, Manitoba Department of Culture, Heritage and Recreation regarding the protection of significant archeaological resources within the project.
