IMPERIAL OIL LIMITED: APPLICANT

The following limits, terms, and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the operation of a fertilizer storage and supply facility on part of SW1/4, Section 35, Township 20, Range 28 WPM, in the Rural Municipality of Russell in the Province of Manitoba.

- 1. The Applicant shall limit the emission of particulate matter from the operation to such an extent that airborne particulate matter from any part or process of the operation does not, at anytime, exhibit an opacity in excess of 5 percent past the property line of the operation.
- 2. The Applicant shall ensure that all product spillage is contained and removed in a manner acceptable to the Director such that groundwater and/or surface water contamination is prevented; and that any spillage is cleaned up on a daily basis.
- 3. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times consistent with meeting the requirements of this Licence.
