THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO: MANITOBA HYDRO: APPLICANT

The following terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with a high voltage direct current (HVDC) transmission line known as the Bipole II Backup Crossing located between the Henday Converter Station on the north side of the Nelson River near Limestone and the existing Bipole II transmission line south of the Nelson River:

- 1. The Applicant shall consult with the local Natural Resources Officer and the Regional Fisheries Manager for the area before undertaking any construction activity in areas susceptible to erosion.
- 2. The Applicant shall prohibit the use of heavy equipment in areas where the deposits and gradients are such that disturbance of the protective vegetative cover will result in erosion. Erosion control methods shall be applied as recommended by the local Natural Resources Officer and the Regional Fisheries Manager for the area.
- 3. The Applicant shall monitor the effectiveness of erosion control methods applied under Clause 2 and shall undertake any further mitigation to control erosion as recommended by the local Natural Resources Officer and Regional Fisheries Manager for the area.
- 4. The Applicant shall provide the Wildlife Branch, Department of Natural Resources, with a detailed report on eagles in the area and shall undertake an eagle survey during the summer of 1991 to determine eagle concentrations along the Nelson River. The results of the eagle survey shall be provided to the Wildlife Branch, Department of Natural Resources for use in the habitat management of eagles along the Nelson River.
