The following limits, terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the construction and operation of the Brandon Crocus Plains 115 - 12 kV Station located on part of the legal subdivision 12, NW 1/4 1-10-19 WPM approximately 1440 feet south of Patricia Avenue and immediately east of 1st Street in the R.M. of Cornwallis:

- 1. The Applicant shall construct the station at the location described as site #1 in The Environment Act Proposal dated August 8, 1991.
- 2. The Applicant shall not cause or permit the emission of sound from the station which when measured beyond the property line of the station in a residential area exceeds an hourly equivalent sound level of 45 dBA during the night time hours of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. local time.
- 3. The Applicant shall install oil spill containment equipment around the station transformers consistent with Plans and Specifications to be approved by the Director prior to construction.
