THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

CORNIE'S MEAT CUTTING (CORNIE BANMAN): APPLICANT

The following limits, terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the operation of a custom meat cutting and wrapping business and smoke house identified as Cornie's Meat Cutting located on Lot 15, Blk 2, Plan 1886 MLTO in the SE part of 33-1-4 WPM in the Village of Hochfeld in the Rural Municipality of Stanley.

- 1. The Applicant shall direct and collect for disposal all of the waste water, which is generated in the course of meat processing operation, initially into a grease trap or interceptor prior to entering a registered disposal system.
- 2. The Applicant shall ensure that all bones and renderable offal are removed and processed by a rendering operation.
- 3. The Applicant shall dispose of all unsaleable or unrenderable waste products from the meat processing operation at a registered waste ground capable of accepting these substances.
- 4. The Applicant shall not store or locate waste materials from the meat processing operation in the open.
- 5. The Applicant shall operate the plant and property in accordance with good housekeeping practices to ensure prevention of nuisance conditions, public health and environmental concerns.
- 6. The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emissions from any process of the operation do not at any time exceed 0.23 grams per standard cubic meter, calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury at the point of emission.
- 7. The Applicant shall ensure that visible smoke emissions from the operation do not exhibit an opacity in excess of:
 - a) 20 percent for a period exceeding 4 minutes in the aggregate in any one hour.
 - b) 40 percent at any time at the point of emission.

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- 8. The Applicant shall ensure that the emissions of odour from the operation are not detectable at any point of impingement beyond the property line in a residential area when one volume of odorous air is diluted with one volume of odour-free air.
- 9. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times consistent with meeting the requirements of Clauses 6, 7, and 8 of this Licence.
