## MANITOBA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS: APPLICANT

The following terms and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the construction and rehabilitation of the upgrade of P.T.H. #10 from 1.2 km. north of the Red Deer River to 0.1km. north of the Overflowing River:

- 1) The Applicant shall adhere to the guidelines specified in "Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings In Manitoba" unless otherwise authorized by the Manitoba Fisheries Branch, Department of Natural Resources.
- 2) The Applicant shall stabilize with rock rip-rap the downstream areas of all crossings of un-named creeks and natural drainage areas into Lake Winnipegosis as specified by the Regional Fisheries Biologist.
- 3) The Applicant shall locate borrow areas a minimum distance of 100 metres away from major water bodies including the Red Deer River, Overflowing River and Lake Winnipegosis.
- 4) The Applicant shall consult with the Regional Fisheries and Wildlife Biologists regarding the selection, preparation, and reclamation of borrow pits
- 5) The Applicant shall avoid in stream construction activity between April 15 and June 15, particularly on the Overflowing River and Beaver Creek.
- 6) The Applicant shall control in stream siltation on the Overflowing River during bridge construction and shall stabilize all disturbed shoreline areas and ditch approaches as specified by the Regional Fisheries Biologist.
- 7) The Applicant shall remove the temporary crossing on the Overflowing River in compliance with the work permit conditions #8745 relative to the removal of material, site restoration and timing

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8) The Applicant shall contact the Regional Fisheries Biologist and the Regional Wildlife Biologist to arrange for a site inspection of the completed work
