THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: LICENCEE

The Licencee shall comply with the following terms and condition for the construction of the realignment of Provincial Road #260 with Provincial Road #216 (" the realigned roadway"), located near the Village of Plumas, in the Ru al Municipality of Westbourne. The construction of the road shall be in accordance with the Key Plan prepared by the Department of Highways titled " Proposed Ken caston of P.R. #260 " filed as additional information on January 28, 1992, the Ep aro ment Act Proposal, dated July 9, 1990.

- 1) The Licencee shall haul all garbage numerial from the abandoned waste disposal ground exhumed during contruction of the realigned right-of-way to a registered Municipal waste disposal ground.
- 2) The Licencee shall provide the Director with advance notice at least one week prior to backfilling the exposed cut of the realigned right-of-way. The Licencee shall not backfill the exposed cut until an Environment Officer has completed a site investigation to ensure that all garbage has been removed from the abandoned landfill are within the realigned right-of-way.
- 3) The Licencee shall backfill the face and bottom of the exposed cut through the abandoned and a rea of the realigned right-of-way with compacted clay fill to a depth of 2 feet.
- 4) The Licencee shall, following completion of the realigned roadway, backfill all areas of the abandoned waste disposal ground exposed during construction with compacted clay fill.

- 5) The Licencee shall construct the Jordan Drain crossing in accordance with the "Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba."
- 6) The Licencee shall, following completion of the crossing structure, reestablish the profile of the Jordan Drain at that location.
- 7) The Licencee shall seed areas that previously supported native vegetation with a mixture of native or introduced grasses.
