In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

Sagkeeng First Nation: "The Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being the Traverse Bay Breakwater and Beach located in North-west Quarter of Section 31 Township 20 Range 9 EPM on the most north-westerly portion of the Fort Alexander Indian Reserve (I.R. 3) subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

DEFINITIONS

In this Licence:

" natural state" means that regular maintenance and upgrading may occur but clearing or removal of the natural vegetation, thereby changing the natural character of the area, will not occur.

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the plans and specifications provided to Manitoba Environment in the document **Sagkeeng First Nation, March 1992**, prepared by Andrew R. Bruyere and submitted on March 30th, 1992. The document was filed as information in support of the Environment Act Proposal Form dated March 10, 1992.
- 2) Notwithstanding Clause 1) of this Licence, the Licencee shall construct the Breakwater portion of the Development with a side slope of a single unit of vertical rise for every three units of horizontal run (3:1) on the Traverse Bay side of the Breakwater and a side slope of a single unit of vertical rise for every two units of horizontal run (2:1) on the beach facing side of the Breakwater.

- 3) The Licencee shall re-establish and maintain the beach portions of the Development in their natural state.

REVOCATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the specifications, limits, terms or conditions set out herein the Director may, temporarily or permanently, revoke this Licence.
