THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licenc ee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being the relocation of Provincial Road #325 located in the LGD of Fisher beginning at the intersection with Provincial Trunk Highway #17 at the N.W. corner of the N.W. 1/4 19-25-3W and extending in a westerly direction a distance of 19.3 km. to N.E. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of 24-25-2W subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal, Proposed Relocation of Provincial Road #325 (from PTH #17 Westerly).
- 2. The Licencee shall construct all stream crossings along the relocated right-of-way in accordance with the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Recommended Fish Protection Procedures for Stream Crossings in Manitoba.
- 3. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, arrange a pre-construction meeting with the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Regional Fisheries Manager in order to ensure compliance with site specific recommendations regarding stream crossing requirements.
- 4. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, submit a report to the Director which describes the mitigation agreed to between the Licencee and the landowners concerns regarding drainage and loss of shelterbelt.
- 5. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from the high water line of the Fisher River, and shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.

6. The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit pursuant to Manitoba Regulation 150/91R respecting Waste Disposal Grounds..

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
