In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE CITY OF WINNIPEG: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a bridge rehabilitation project on Portage Avenue at Omands Creek in the City of Winnipeg subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated September 2, 1994.
- 2. The Licencee shall ensure that no instream construction activities associated with the Development occur between April 1 and June 15 of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall dispose of water used in the hydrodemolition process in a sanitary sewer after solids have been removed in a settling basin.
- 4. The Licencee shall construct cofferdams using sandbags for portions of the project which require instream work. The cofferdams shall be completely removed from the channel following construction.
- 5. The Licencee shall ensure that any water within cofferdams which contains a significant amount of sediment is discharged to a vegetated area or a settling basin. Sediment laden water shall not be discharged directly to a watercourse.
- 6. The Licencee shall ensure that all riprap and other revetment material used in the construction of the Development is clean, free of fine materials, and capable of resisting displacement during peak flood events.
- 7. The Licencee shall ensure that the materials used to stabilize the bed and banks of Omands Creek do not reduce the cross sectional area of the creek from its present area.
- 8. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with all applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.

9. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.*

REVOCATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
