THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE MINNEDOSA FISH ENHANCEMENT COMMITTEE: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a bank stabilization and fish habitat enhancement project on the Little Saskatchewan River in S 19-16-18W in the Rural Municipality of Minto subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated February 7, 1995.
- 2. The Licencee shall not undertake instream construction or maintenance works between April 1 and June 15 of any year.
- 3. The Licencee shall, during construction of the Development, ensure that measures are taken to prevent the entry of riverbank material and sediment due to water erosion into the Little Saskatchewan River.
- 4. The Licencee shall protect streambanks disturbed by construction and subject to water erosion with riprap. Other exposed soil shall be reseeded with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 5. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 6. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 metres away from any waterbody, and shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
