In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being the upgrading of Provincial Road #329 beginning at the junction of Provincial Trunk Highway #17 in the L.G.D. of Fisher and proceeding in an easterly direction for a distance of 21.6 kilometers to the junction of Provincial Road #233 in the Rural Municipality of Bifrost subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal Proposed Upgrading of Provincial Road 329 (from PTH 17 to PR 233), dated April 2, 1995.
- 2) The Licencee shall, prior to construction, provide a copy of this Licence to all contractors and sub-contractors involved in the Development.
- 3) The Licencee shall, prior to construction, ensure that the contractor obtains a burning permit from the Department of Natural Resources District office in Hodgson for the disposal of any slash and debris associated with the Development.
- 4) The Licencee shall, prior to construction, consult and reach an agreement with the Director of the Central Region of the Department of Natural Resources with regard to the size of the culverts and drains associated with the Development.
- 5) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that natural wetlands in the project area are not affected by the Development.
- The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage and fueling areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 metres away from the high water line of any watercourse and wetland within the Development area and shall comply with the requirements of Manitoba Regulation 97/88R respecting Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products.
- 7) The Licencee shall, during the modification or rebuilding of any timber crossing structures related to the Development, not use timbers treated with cresosote or pentachlorophenol.

- The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit pursuant to the Manitoba Waste Disposal Ground Regulation, MR 150/91.
- 9) The Licencee shall, following construction, vegetate disturbed areas with native grasses or herbs.

REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms and conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
