## MANITOBA POOL ELEVATORS - NETLEY: "the Licencee"

for the installation and operation of the Development being a crop protection products warehouse, a bulk granular fertilizer blending/storage, grain elevator, and distribution facilities to be located on property leased from the Canadian Pacific Limited on the NE 1/4 10-16-4 EPM in the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews, subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

### DEFINITIONS

In this Licence,

"**A-weighted sound level**" means the sound level measured in dBA units with a sound level meter set on the A-weighting network, being a filter designed to approximate the relative sensitivity of the normal human ear to different frequencies of sound;

"**ambient concentration**" means the measurement of a substance contained in an air sample (corrected to a temperature of 25 ° C and to a pressure of 101.3 kilopascals) which has been collected from any point beyond the property line of the Development;

"**appreciable impulsive or impact character**" means sound which has a significant amount of impulsive or impact nature, such as hammering, explosion, or other
