- 3. The Licencee split raice e production and dissemination of wastes by initiating and main aning waste redu ion and waste recycling programs.

### REC SICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Licence is dereby authorized to undertake the following activities related to the testing and commissioning of new works as proposed and related to the expanded part at the Development, for the period of December 16, 1996, to December 23, 1996:
  - operation of processing equipment shall not exceed four separate test runs;
  - n, any test run shall not exceed eight hours duration;
  - iii) test run production rate shall not exceed 7.5 tonnes per hour finished product;
  - iv) test run products shall not be packaged for sale; and
  - v) effluent quality shall be controlled to minimize the impact on the municipal sewage treatment system.

- 5. The Licencee is hereby authorized to undertake the following activities related to the testing and commissioning of new works as proposed and related to the expanded production at the Development, for the period of December 24, 1996, to January 1, 1997:
  - i) operation of processing equipment shall not exceed two separate test ry
  - ii) any test run shall not exceed eight hours duration;
  - iii) test run production rate shall not exceed 15 tonnes per hour finish product;
  - iv) test run products shall not be packaged for sale; and
  - v) effluent quality shall be controlled to minimize the impact on the nunicipal sewage treatment system.
- 6. The Licencee shall carry out any remedial measures or modern ons to authorized under this Licence which may be deemed ensure effective environmental management or for aining to the ry othe safety of the construction in this Licence and in a stage in the licensing √ subsequex of the Development. Such remedial measures of shall be undertaken odification within a time frame to be specified by the Dir. tor, an er to be approved by in a ma the Director.

## REVIEW AND

- A. If in the opinion of the Director, the vicence has exceeded or is exceeding or has or is failing to meet the specifications, like s, tend or conditions set out in this Licence, the Director may, temporary or permanently, revoke this Licence.
