AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: The Clean Environment Commission and East West Packers Ltd., applicant

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of the Clean Environment Act, East West Packers Ltd., 346 Dupuy Street, St. Boniface, Winnipeg submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of an animal slaughtering, packing and processing plant, including edible and inedible rendering and blood drying, located on Lot 25/26, 27/28, Plan 3197 at or near 346 Dupu Street, St. Boniface, City of Winnipeg,

AND WHEREAS

a representation was made to the Clear Er fromment Commission by a person who is or is likely to be after ted by an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connect a with the said operation,

AND WHEREAS

the Clean Environment Commission held a public hearing on the 26th, 27th and 28th days of June 1972 in the Archwood School in St. Boniface, City of Winning, Manitoba,

AND WHEREAS

the Clean Environment Commission considered the said application on the 22nd day of January, 1973 and issued Order No. 241,

AND WHEREAS

the applicant stated to the Clean Environment Commission a request for the variation of the said Order,

AND WHEREAS

the Clean Environment Commission held a public hearing on the 15th day of July, 1974 in the Board Room of Building 2 of the Fort Osborne Complex at 139 Tuxedo Avenue, Winnipeg for the purpose of hearing evidence in connection with the said request for variation of the said Order,

AND WHEREAS

the Clean Environment Commission considered the request of the applicant for variation of the said Order on the 23rd day of July, 1974,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT ORDER NO. 241 BE VARIED TO READ AS FOLLOWS

Ossignment same.

1. The applicant shall, not later than the 31st day of January, 1975, install and set in operation equipment and facilities to effectively reduce malodour emanating from inedible rendering cookers and/or blood driers,

- 2. The applicant shall ensure that on and after the 1st day of February, 1975
 - (a) gases and vapours discharged from inedible rendering cookers and/or blood driers to the air contain less than one hundred and fifty (150) odour units per standard cubic foot and that said gases and vapours are not diluted before measurement except as required
 - (i) to introduce combustion gases or chemical reactants necessary for odour abatement, or
 - (ii) to assure gathering of sid gases and vapours,
 - sampling points are provided in the exhaust system from the inedible rendering cookers and/or the blood driers in conformity with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Branch of the separtment of Mines, Resources and Environmental Manager.
- 3. The applicant shall ensure that on and after the 1st day of February, 1975 at any point of impingment off the plant premises the atmospher con aims less than seven (7) odour units per standar cubic root, emanating from the said operation,
- 4. The applicant shall ensure that:
 - (a) all door control and reduction equipment and facilities are mintained and in sound operating condition, and
 - (b) all odour control and reduction equipment and facilities are in operation whenever or however the said cookers and/or blood driers are in use,
- 5. The applicant shall ensure that general housekeeping and maintence measures are of a standard that will meet the requirements in Clause 3 of this Order.
