AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION



UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: The Clean Environment Commission and Canadian Gypsum Company, Limited applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Canadian Gypsum Company, Limited has submitted an application to the Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of an asphalt shingle and sheeting paper plant located on Block M, Plan 433 (421 Archibald Street) in the parish of St. Boniface, Winnipeg,

AND WHEREAS representation was made to the Clean Environment Commission by a person who is or is likely to be affected by an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation,

AND WHEREAS the Clean Environment Commission held a public hearing on June 26th, 27th and 28th, 1972 at the Archwood School Auditorium, St. Boniface, Winnipeg and again on March 5th and 6th at Building 2, 139 Tuxedo Avenue, Winnipeg,

AND WHEREAS the Clean Environment Commission considered the application on the 14th day of May 1973,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The applicant shall ensure that particulate emissions from the various processes shall not exceed 0.57 grams per standard cubic meter of air calculated at 20 degrees Centigrade and 760 millimeters of mercury at the point of emission,
- 2. The applicant shall ensure that at any point of impingement off the plant premises that:
 - (1) suspended particulate concentrations shall not exceed 100 micrograms per standard cubic meter of air for any 24 hour period,
 - (2) odour eminating from the said operation shall be less than 7 odour units per standard cubic foot of air,
