AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM, RECREATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS, Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Parks Branch of the Department of Tourism, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, submitted an application to The Clean Environment Commission in connection with the operation of a self-contained sewage lagoon system located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5-25-17 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Ochre River, Manitoba, to serve Rainbow Beach Provincial Park;

AND WHEREAS a representation was made to the said Commission by a person who is, or is likely to be, affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission held a public hearing in the Council Chambers of the Civic Administrative Building in Dauphin, Manitoba, on the 4th day of March, 1975;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the application on the 28th day of April, 1975;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that the said sewage lagoon system is constructed, maintained and operated in such a manner as to:



1. Cont'd . . .
 - (a) prevent the contamination of groundwater by ensuring there is no percolation of sewage from the primary lagoon of the said system; and
 - (b) minimize the release of malodour.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that the organic loading (in terms of five-day biochemical oxygen demand) on the primary cell of the said sewage lagoon system does not exceed 50 pounds per acre per day.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that there is no discharge of effluent from the said sewage lagoon system to any surface watercourse.
