AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and the FRONTIER SCHOOL DIVISION NO. 48, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Frontier School Division No. 48 submitted an application to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a sewage lagoon system located in or near Thicket Portage, Manitoba, serving the Thicket Portage School and Teacherages with discharge of effluent to Wintering Lake;

AND WHEREAS

no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation.

AND WHEREAS

the said application was considered on the 15th day of September, 1975;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The Applicant shall ensure that the said sewage lagoon system is maintained and operated in such a manner as to:
 - (a) prevent the contamination of groundwater;
 - (b) minimize the release of offensive odours; and
 - (c) ensure the organic loading on the primary cell of the said system, in terms of five-day biochemical oxygen demand, does not exceed 50 pounds per acre per day.
