AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and DYCKS CONTAINERS AND FOREST PRODUCTS LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act,
Dycks Containers and Forest Products Ltd. submitted an
application to The Clean Environment Commission in
connection with the operation of a wood manufacturing plant
located at or near 305 McKay Avenue in the City of
Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is, or who is likely to be, affected by an Order of the said Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the said application on the 26th day of January, 1976;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emission from any stack or vent of the said operation do not exceed 0.57 grams per standard cubic metre calculated at 20 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury.
- The Applicant shall ensure that general housekeeping and maintenance measures are of such standard as to prevent unnecessary entrainment of nuisance wood particulate past the property line of the said plant.
- 3. The Applicant shall ensure that at any point of impingement off the premises of the said operation the concentration of suspended particulate matter arising from the said operation in any period of 24 hours does not exceed 100 micrograms per cubic metre of air.

The Applicant shall ensure that sawdust, shavings or chips shipped from the premises of the said operation are not loaded on vehicles unless: (a) the vehicle is so designed and constructed as to carry the load without leakage; and (b) the load is covered in such a manner as to prevent the wind entrainment of particles; or (c) the material is so arranged that the highest part of the load does not exceed the height of the box and/or tailgate of the vehicle. 538 Order No. Dated at the City of Winnipeg FEBRUARY this 23rd day of Chairman, The Clean Environment Commission.
