AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE TOWN OF STONEWALL, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Town of Stonewall filed a proposal with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management in connection with the operation of a program for the control of forest tent caterpillars and fall cankerworms by the application of the insecticide Malathion to trees in the Town:

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS

a representation was made to the Commission by a person who is, or who is likely to be, affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission held a public hearing in the Town of Stonewall on the 27th day of April, 1976;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission having considered the evidence adduced at the public hearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that all insecticides applied in connection with the said program have been duly registered in accordance with applicable statutes and regulations issued by the governments of Canada and Manitoba and that the purposes for which the insecticides are used and the manner and rate of application are in accordance with the directions and limits prescribed therein.

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2. The Applicant shall ensure that:

(a) all reasonable precautions are taken to prevent the contamination of bodies of water other than stagnant pools; and

- 2. (b) residual insecticide and/or insecticide containers are disposed of in such a manner as not to contaminate the environment.
- 3. The Applicant shall, before the commencement of the said program, give public notice as to the nature of the program, the type of insecticides to be used and the anticipated dates and duration of the program.
- 4. The Applicant shall, on or before the last day of each calendar year in which the program is carried out or continued under the terms of this Order, advise the Commission as to whether or not it is intended to continue the program in the ensuing year.
