## AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

## UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and FEED-RITE LTD., Applicant,

## WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Feed-Rite Mills (1962) Ltd. filed a proposal with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management in connection with the operation of a feed mill to be located on part of Parcel 2 shown on a survey plan of survey on part of lot 297 of the Roman Catholic Mission Property filed in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as Number 7791, at or near 17 Speers Road, Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS

the name of the applicant company was changed to Feed-Rite Ltd. on the 2nd day of January, 1976;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS

no representation was made to the Commission by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission considered the proposal on the 10th day of May, 1976;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- 1. The Applicant shall ensure that particulate emissions from any stack or vent of the said operation do not exceed 0.23 grams per standard cubic metre calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury (0.10 grains per standard cubic foot calculated at 77 degrees Fahrenheit and 30 inches of mercury).
- 2. The Applicant shall ensure that odours arising from the said operation are not detectable:

- 2. (a) at the point of emission when one volume of odourous air is diluted with 149 volumes of odour-free air; and
  - (b) at any point of impingement off the premises of the said operation when one volume of odourous air is diluted with six volumes of odour-free air;

as determined by two samples taken not less than 15 minutes apart and not more than one hour apart.

3. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of maintenance and housekeeping is maintained at all times consistent with meeting the limits prescribed in this Order.
