

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and S.P. PAINT FACTORY LTD, Applicant,

- WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, S.P. Paint Factory Ltd., filed a proposal with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management in connection with the operation of a plant for the manufacture of latex and oil based paints located at or near 135 Paramount Road in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;
- AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the said proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;
- AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is or who is likely to be affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;
- AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the proposal on the 27th day of September, 1976;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emissions from any stack or vent of the said plant do not exceed 0.23 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury (0.10 grains per standard cubic foot calculated at 77 degrees Fahrenheit and 29.92 inches of mercury) at any point of emission.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that at any point of impingement off the site of the said plant, odours shall not be detectable in any industrial area or area zoned industrial when one volume of odourous air is diluted with six volumes of odour-free air.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices are carried out at all times so as to facilitate compliance with Clauses 1 and 2 of this Order.
