AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and MR. BRUNO PETER, Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Mr. Bruno Peter filed an application with the Department in connection with the operation of an electric motor rewinding and repair shop known as B & B Dynamo and Armature located at or near 431 Turenne Road in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS no representations were made to the Commission by any person who is or who may be affected by an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 21st day of April, 1980;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall not permit the emission of solid particulate matter from the incinerator oven of the said operation to exceed a concentration of 0.23 grams per standard cubic meter of dry flue gas calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury corrected to 12 percent carbon dioxide, by volume.
  2. The Applicant shall not permit smoke emissions, from the incinerator, the opacity of which is equal to or greater than:
    - (a) 40 percent at any time;
    - (b) 20 percent for a period exceeding 4 minutes in any one hour.
